Chamber Board Welcomes Four New Members



Public Policy Committee Scores Legislative Session

The regular session of the 88th Texas Legislature adjourned May 29.



Compared against the Chamber's Legislative Agenda prepared by the Public Policy committee, results were

strong in the areas of Business Competitiveness and Higher Education. Unfortunately, "No bill was passed to provide school districts with funding to meet increased expenses and provide salary increases for teachers and school personnel. Districts will budget based on 2019 funding levels."

While the legislature continues to meet in special session, the **<u>agenda set forth</u>** by Gov. Greg Abbott calls for a focus on property taxes.


