<u>10 constitutional amendments on Texas Nov. 5 ballot;</u> early voting until Nov. 1

Texas voters will vote on 10 proposed amendments to the state constitution this year, which deal with everything from retiring law enforcement animals to the state's tax code. Richardson residents will choose the board of trustees for the RISD.

Texans will be asked to vote on these propositions about a wide range of topics from allowing judges to hold more than one office to cancer funding. A summary of all 10 propositions drafted by the chamber's Public Policy committee are on the website. The chamber's board of directors have endorsed propositions 6 and 7.
